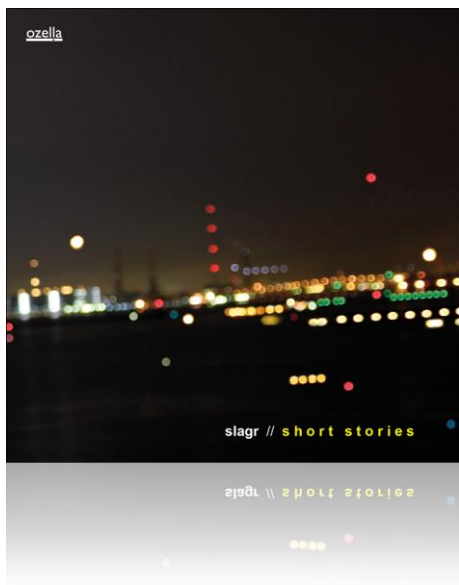

Auf „Short Stories“ gelingt es dem norwegischen Trio Slagr der Zeit einen Klang zu geben. Mit Hardanger Fidel, Vibraphon und Cello weben sie kunstvolle, an- und abschwellende Klangteppiche, auf welchen fast vergessene Volkslied-Motive und Geschichten auftauchen und wieder verschwinden. Dabei schaffen Slagr ein eigenes, neues Genre, dass die norwegische Folk-Tradition mit Elementen aus Neuer Musik und Ambient verbindet.
