## Helge Lien | Knut Hem Villingsberg

Knut Hem and Helge Lien's collaboration feels like transatlantic telepathy: Warm Americana represented by Weissenborn guitar and dobro in one corner; and cool Norwegian jazz spirits expressed through quicksilvery piano lines in the other. But isn't distance irrelevant in art anyway? In Christopher Nolan's Interstellar, Dr. Amelia Brand argues: "Love is the one thing we're capable of perceiving that transcends dimensions of time and space."

But so, too, does music.

Knut Hem grew up in the smallish rural town of Hønefoss. His creative outlook, however, was firmly global: When a Country craze hit Norway in the 80s, he was swept along with it as well, falling in love with the crystalline sound of Weissenborn guitars.

Helge Lien's youth was spent in an even more rural part of Norway, and as a boy, he was surrounded by the folk music played at home by his mother. Only much later, during his university years, he discovered Keith Jarrett's My Song album – and instantly experienced a strange sense of kinship.

Hem and Lien never questioned these feelings. They never set out to record a concept album, either. This is simply what they sound like when they get together to make music. The longing and sense of bittersweet beauty expressed by *Villingsberg* is universal, primal, fundamental. It truly does transcend dimensions of time and space. As Dr. Amelia Brand would put it: Maybe we should trust that, even if we can't understand it.
